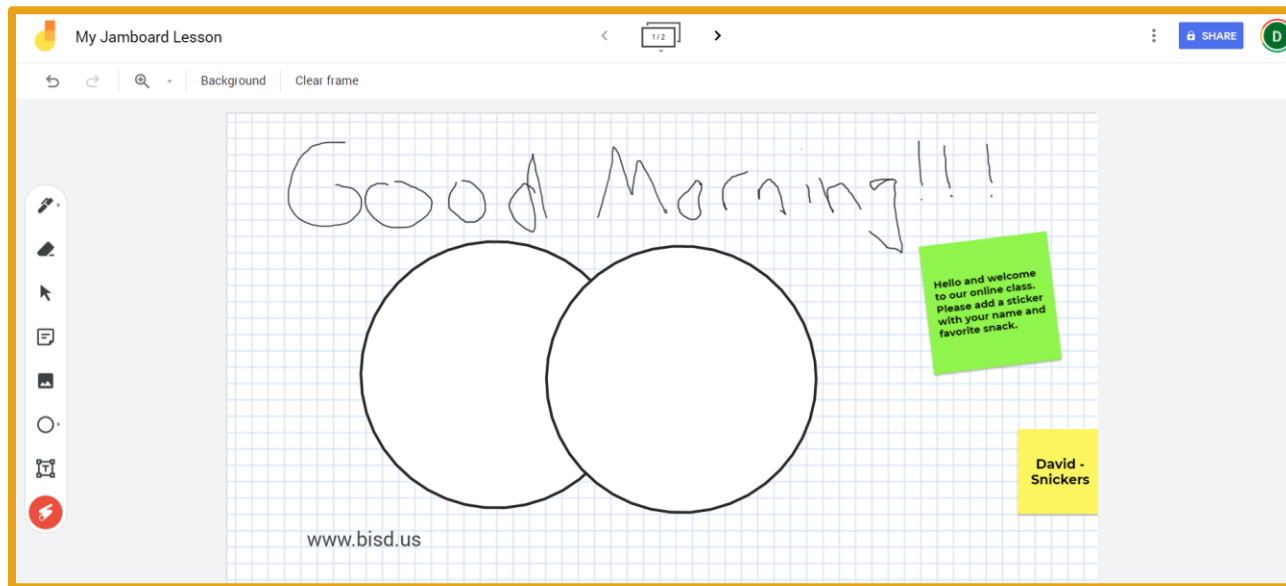

Google Jamboard



- Write “Welcome” erase, then use a Text box to be neater
- **Share** the board : use share with anyone as an **editor**
- Add a sticker with instructions, “Add your name and favorite snack in a note. Use green” then have students use another color for additional notes.
- Add a new frame, add an image then have students comment on it.
- Add a new board and a Venn diagram with added text boxes differences with similarities in the center. (ellipsis shows **order**, **duplicate** and **delete** also fill a **Fill color** at the top with **border color** as well)
- Teachers led or posted online



What is a Hyperdoc

- A Hyperdoc is document filled with links intended to guide students through a lesson that is with either teacher led or independent
- It addresses the 4C's (Communication, Collaboration, Critical Thinking, and Creating)
- “Hyper” Links are used to make the document interactive and more inquiry based
- Organized and efficient (everything is in one place)
- Imagine every online tool as a possible link(Look for “Sharing” on any app)
- Use Google Docs, Slides, Sheets, and additional apps like Wakelet.com and Padlet as well as Microsoft Office etc.


